### World of Wizardry - \$7.50 (\$6.00 BYO pot)

Add a little Harry Potter and the World of Wizardry to your life with Suskia. Make a wand to cast some spells, study how to care for a dragon and show your green thumb by helping grow a Mandrake. All children, big or small, need a little magic in their dolls' house.

#### TOOLS:

Fine sand paper  
Glue  
Thin nosed pliers  
Wire cutters  
Scissors  
Tiny bit of brown paint  
Small box to protect Mandrake to take home to dry

Jig (or Lego blocks)  
Tacky glue & gel superglue  
Sharp scissors for fabric  
Acrylic paint in your choice of colour/s  
Wire cutters

#### TOOLS:

General toolbox  
Craft knife with sharp blade  
Tacky glue  
Black, white and silver paint  
Gloss varnish

#### TOOLS:

Craft mat, General toolbox with fine scissors, fine tweezers, small and medium stylus, tacky glue and superglue, pliers, wire cutters, masking tape, white Gesso, smallish old paintbrushes, mousepad or foam to shape flowers on, piece of oasis, some material to paint on and bring your own pot if you like.  
Paints: acrylic burgundy, burnt umber (Jo Sonja's), light beige (e.g. Ghost Gum by Matisse or similar)  
Watercolour pencils: burgundy and dark yellow
